Would you like to be one of many youth to help make a difference for your peers in Scouts Canada?

Scouts Canada is looking for a new **Assistant National Youth Commissioner (ANYC)** for **Central Canada** to do just that. The ANYC-Central works in partnership with the ANYC's of Western and Eastern Canada to provide service and support to all the Council Youth Commissioners (CYC) and to assist the National Youth Commissioner when needed. In addition, the ANYC is a member of the National Youth Network, the National Service Team to represent the CYC's (Council Youth Commissioners) of Central Canada and to collaborate with other National personnel. The ANYC is also responsible for facilitating meetings and/or conference calls with CYC's in their geographic region (Ontario and Quebec).

ACCOUNTABLE TO: The National Youth Commissioner

TERM: Appointed annually by the National Youth Commissioner, for a maximum of three (3) consecutive years.

TIME REQUIRED: At least 15-20 hours per month, in addition to required meetings;

- 1 National Youth Network meeting per year.
- 1 National Scouters Conference.
- A couple National Service Team Meetings or Conference Calls annually.
- Numerous phone calls/e-mails.

ROLE: As a member of the National Service Team & National Youth Network, you will be responsible for coordinating and servicing the Council Youth Commissioners in their geographic designation.

DUTIES:

1. Serve as a geographic member of the National Youth Network, working for the best interests of the organization as a whole.
2. Work closely with Council Youth Commissioners to ensure they are supported in their role and can effectively represent their Council to the National level.
3. Ensure the effective operations of the Youth Network in their geographic designation.
4. Ensure Council Youth Commissioners maintain an effective relationship with their respective Council Commissioner, and Council Executive Director.
5. Assist the National Youth Commissioner with the operations of the National Youth Network.
6. Liaise with National Service Scouters in their geographic area on relevant matters.
7. Facilitate possible geographic meetings and/or conference calls of Council Youth Commissioners, as assigned by the National Youth Commissioner.
8. Act as a conduit for information between the youth of the geographic territory and the national organization, communicating relevant issues and decisions in both directions.

9. In conjunction with, and under the direction of the National Youth Commissioner, help to fill vacant Council Youth Commissioner positions within the geographic region.
10. Represent the Youth Network and provide insight and input as an active member of the National Service Team.
11. Complete other activities or tasks as agreed upon.

SKILLS REQUIRED:

1. Must be between 14-26 years old to apply.
2. Previous leadership experience, Scouting or otherwise.
3. Excellent interpersonal skills.
4. Good organizational skills.
5. Ability to motivate others.
6. Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
